
Listen to God!

Mark 6:30-44

(especially 35-44)

The gospel written by John tells us the food was given by a young boy. It was probably his food for the day and certainly wouldn't have fed more than a few people. When given to Jesus it was able to feed thousands with plenty left over. Jesus can take our little and turn it into something big.
