



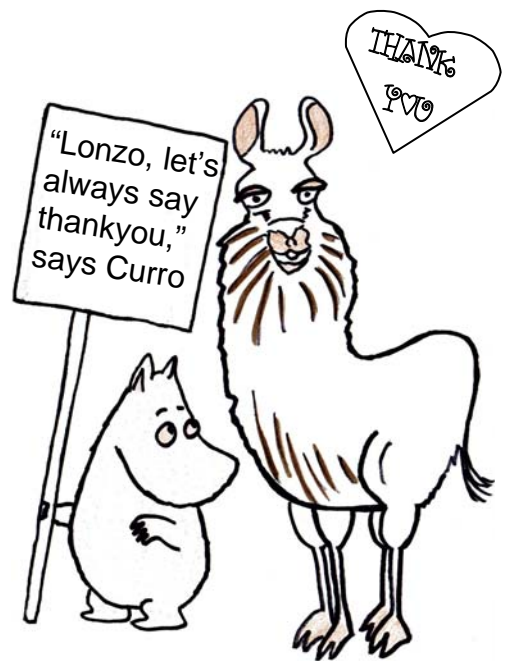
THANK YOU VERY MUCH
