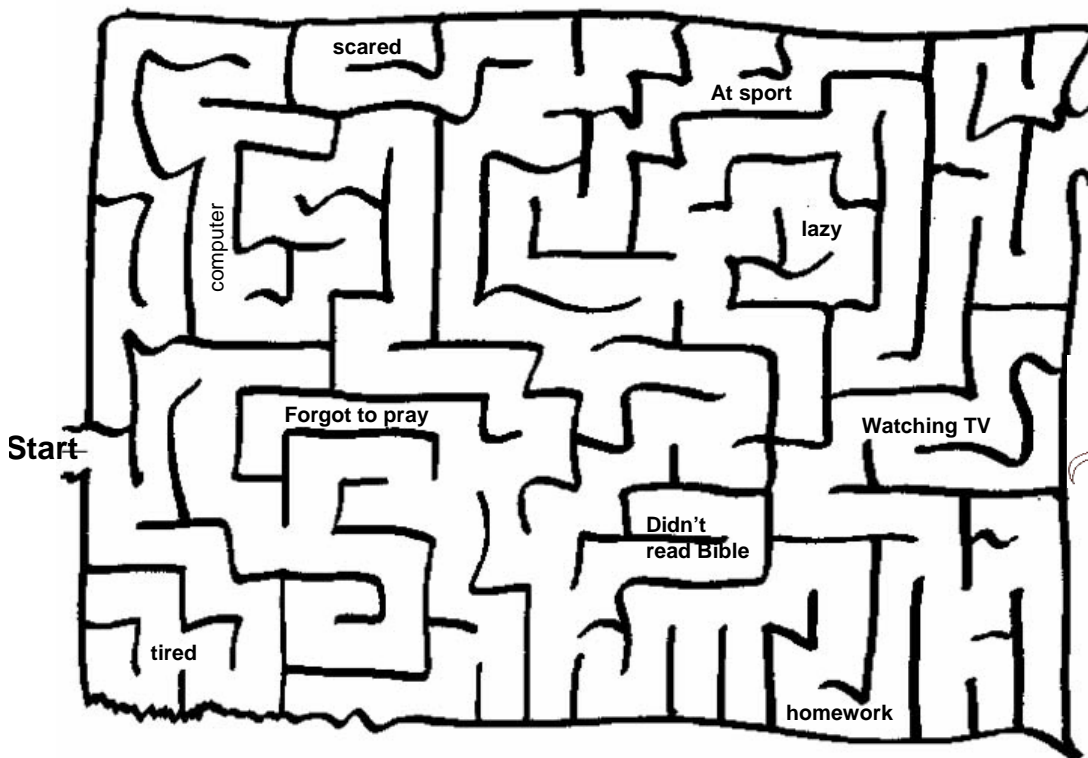


Hermansberg's church
